



REOPENING PLAN for 2020-2021



SCHOOLWIDE HEALTH PROCEDURES AND ADJUSTED SCHOOL ROUTINES TO ADDRESS Covid-19 PANDEMIC:

- Health screening routines for students, staff
- Enhanced sanitizing and cleaning procedures
- Lunches in individual classrooms or designated picnic areas
- Parents and visitors on campus by appointment only
- Student arrivals and dismissals from cars only
- Use of masks as recommended by health authorities and Florida Department of Education
- Supervised and guided personal cleanliness regimens
- Any student, employee, or household member returning to Miami from a destination determined to be a Level 3 Travel Health Notice by CDC or under travel restrictions by state or local authorities will be required to stay at home for 14 days prior to campus return. This includes travel by airplane, train or roadways.
- Social distancing encouraged throughout campus as feasible
- Small class sizes
- Faculty will travel to classrooms
- Elimination of shared equipment and school materials
- Restrooms sanitized throughout day
- Virtual fieldtrips
- No third party vendors or programs
- Signed parent form specific to pandemic
- Remote learning K-5 immediately available in the event for interruption of on-campus learning for a particular classroom or following government authority guidelines or public health officials to maintain health and safety of students and staff
